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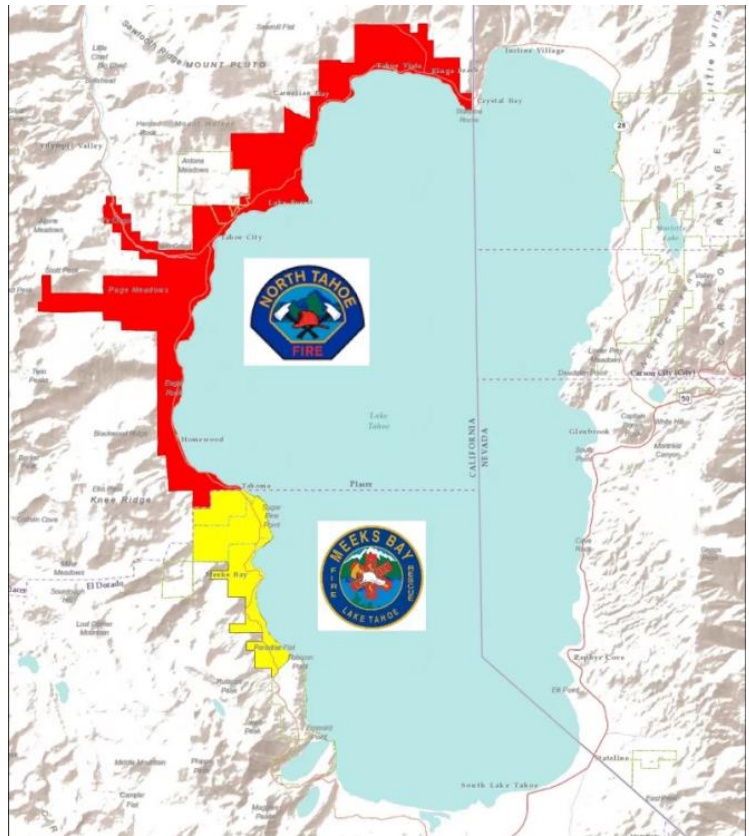

About the District

North Tahoe Fire Protection District was formed in 1993, following the consolidation of the Tahoe City Fire Protection District (Tahoe City, CA) and the North Tahoe Fire Protection District (Kings Beach, CA).

Currently, the District's 65 personnel support our mission: *The North Tahoe Fire Protection District provides the highest possible level of fire and life safety, rescue and emergency medical service, fire prevention, and public education to the citizens and visitors of the communities we serve.* Our communities are situated on 32 square miles on the north and west shores of Lake Tahoe.

This map helps illustrate the size of the District. North Tahoe Fire Protection District boundaries are in the red and Meeks Bay Fire is in the yellow.



North Tahoe Fire Protection District has six fire stations within the District located in Alpine Meadows, Tahoe City, Homewood, Dollar Hill, Carnelian Bay, and Kings Beach, and through an agreement with Meeks Bay Fire Protection District, two additional stations located in Meeks Bay and Tahoma. These stations are staffed by 51 uniformed personnel for nearly 15,000 residents within the area we serve.

The varied demographics of the District provide opportunities for its personnel to respond to emergencies in rural, suburban, and urban settings. The wide diversity of emergency incidents requires firefighters to be proficient in wildland fire fighting, structural firefighting, backcountry/technical rescue, swift water rescue, hazardous materials mitigation, and emergency medical services.



About The Positions

The North Tahoe Fire Protection District is currently accepting applications for a current job opening from qualified individuals for the grant-funded, full-time position of Inspector. The eligibility list established from this recruitment will be used to fill a current vacancy.

Under the direct supervision of the Fire Marshal, with a 40 hour staff assignment to Fire Prevention, the Inspector will perform a variety of tasks relating to Fire Prevention and community risk reduction including conduct Vacation Home Rental/Short Term Rental inspections for fire and life safety in El Dorado and Placer County; defensible space inspections and hazardous tree removal permits; Assist fire prevention staff with public education, community outreach, and Fire Prevention Week activities; assist fire prevention staff and the District Forest Fuels Coordinator with maintaining a database of PRC 4291 and Short Term Rental inspection activity; assist fire prevention staff and the District Forest Fuels Coordinator with the fuels reduction (chipping) program; assist fire prevention staff with Citizen's Emergency Information Team and Community Emergency Response Team programs relating to the WUI; greet and assist the public, answer phones, and other duties as assigned; follow District Standard Operating Procedures, Rules & Regulations, and comply with District Expectations; and performs other related duties.

Minimum Requirements

The applicant must be able to lift objects frequently up to 10 pounds and occasionally up to 25 pounds. He or she must have the ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing; understand the community, organization, and operations of the North Tahoe Fire Protection District; work cooperatively with citizens, community groups, business interests, other District employees, and federal, state, and local agencies.

- Current CPR certification to the Health Care Provider level (required 60 days after employment)

The Examination and Selection Process

The examination process will include an application review, a possible written examination, and an oral interview.

The application review and oral interview will tentatively occur the week of October 10, 2022.

Applicants who are offered employment are subject to a Live Scan, background investigation, and a drug/alcohol screening and physical assessment. Employment is contingent upon passing the Live Scan, background investigation, and drug/alcohol screening.

- Public Employees Retirement System – retirement benefits dependent on employment tier and if candidate is considered a “Classic CalPERS member”
 - District pays 100% of the employer portion and employee pays 100% of the employee portion – No cost share
- 100% District-paid medical, dental, and vision insurance for employee and family.
- Retiree health reimbursement plan (up to 100% coverage upon retirement for employee and family, dependent on length of service).
- 100% District-paid life and long-term disability insurance.
